Green Tea

Bancha Hojicha Japan

Bancha is a classic Japanese large-leaf green tea made from the lower shoots of the tea plant. It contains substantially less caffeine than Sencha teas which are made from young shoots. Bancha Hojicha is made by roasting the Bancha leaves at high temperatures until they turn reddish-brown. Filled with aromatic flavours with roasted and nutty notes, this tea can be enjoyed with a slice of lemon or orange.

Bi Luo Chun Taiwan **

Translated as 'Green Spiral Leaves of Spring', once infused, this tea boasts an outstanding distinctive moist crisp fruity aroma. Peach, apricot and plum trees are planted among the tea bushes, so when these fruit trees bloom, the tender sprouts and buds of the tea absorb the different aromas, resulting in a lingering sweet aftertaste.

Four Seasons Spring Taiwan *

Four Seasons Spring is a great representation of a light fermented tea of about 15% fermentation level. Crispy and sweet with hints of peach and grass feelings, fragrance and flavours are at their full potential. Tea leaves are rolled to tight spherical shaped balls, encouraging multiple infusions for each special occasion. Lively and with a sense of rightness to start the day, the thrust of vitality of Spring lays within every cup.

Genmaicha Japan

Genmaicha means 'Natural Rice Tea'. Japanese Sencha tea is blended with roasted popped rice giving it a pleasant nutty flavour, and although it can be enjoyed at any time of the day, the Japanese prefer to drink this tea in the afternoon because it has low caffeine and a mild flavour along with a warm feeling.

Gunpowder Temple of Heaven China

Gunpowder tea is dried slowly in rotating drums into a very tightly-rolled ball. A well noticeable, rich, nutty green tea with an oaky aroma, it has a slightly dry and fresh flavour. For a classic North African-style taste, a steep with a handful of fresh mint is suggested.

Gyokuro Exclusive Japan ***

A top-class Japanese Sencha tea also known as the 'Dew of Pearl' or 'Most Exquisite Dew Drop', Gyokuro tea plants are grown in the shadow of broad-leaved trees and shaded with bamboo mats for two weeks before being plucked to boost the chlorophyll content and the green character of the tea. It has a high caffeine content and low tannin and the infusion is mild and typically tangy.

Kenya Purple Tea Kenya **

Purple tea, like all other tea originates from the *Camellia Sinensis* plant. The story was told, that the tea seedlings were gifted by the Indian tea growers back in the early 1900's. Purple tea is mainly marketed by Kenya-based tea growers. It's grown at elevations between 1,200 and 2,300 metres above sea level. This high altitude near the equator results in higher levels of UV exposure, and causes the plants to produce very high levels of anti-oxidants to protect the leaves from UV damage. The purple appearance of the tea is caused by an unique genetic mutation that produces anthocyanin, the same powerful anti-oxidant found in blueberries and other blue-appearance vegetables. Anthocyanin has many medicinal properties and is particularly known to be beneficial against cardiovascular diseases. These antioxidants are known to provide anti-cancer benefits, improve vision, and aid in cholesterol, blood sugar metabolism and body mass reduction. At the same time, caffeine content is lower than that of black or green tea. Although it is named purple, due to the low oxidation level and limited withering, roasting and drying processes, it is categorised within green tea, hence temperature for this tea should be around 75-80 degrees Celsius. Grassy and nutty notes, with a delightful light purple radiance..

Longjing China **

This well-known fine green tea is also called 'Dragon Well'. Known for its unique distinct shape with flattened leaves, fine white hair and smooth appearance, this tea manifests nutty, sweet, buttery and creamy sensations just before its fresh and tender aftertastes come forward.

Matcha Powder Japan **

Top buds are hand plucked to dry and then stone-ground to reveal the ultra-greenness of the tea. Stone grinding is an art much like making ceramic. This high-grade Matcha has intense sweetness with deep colour and flavour. Incorporating matcha powder in baking is one of the most natural ways of food colouring.

Sencha Fukujyu Japan

A middle-grade Sencha from Shizuoka on the slopes of Mount Fuji, Sencha means "steamed tea" because the tea is lightly steamed before being rolled and dried to preserve the freshness and the green character of the tea leaf. It has a distinctive, strong, green tea character special to green tea lovers.

Thailand Royal Thailand

From the wild of the Mountains of Tenasserim in the Royal Kingdom of Thailand through to Myanmar, the tea is harvested from rural communities before presented to us with fruitiness, grassiness, sweetness and woodiness in each sip.

Bai Mu Dan Organic Taiwan **

This special varietal named Taiwan #23, is grown in the Bamboo Mountain district in the centre of the island of Taiwan. With a small leaf style with natural fruit and floral fragrance, Taiwan#23 is a varietal with high vitality in its growth and can adapt to the hot and dry slopes. This tea has a signature tight astringency, meaning it releases its strength and richness gradually while expressing a bright light orange in colour. The perfect white tea with its young buds leaves makes it a very pleasant cup of tea connection.

Bai Mu Tan China *

A white tea named after 'White Peony Flower' produced in China's Fujian province. The terminal bud and two leaves are plucked only in spring before being dried in the sun or closed rooms with no other processing. The infusion is a delicate light orange, and the tea has a pleasant mild flavour.

Mao Jian China *

Mao Jian is one of the many varieties in Chinese green tea distinguished by its hairy, fine and corded mosaic appearance of white and green tea leaves. Grassy and fruity notes can be found beneath to form an unforgettable finish.

Another great white tea produced in China's Fujian province. The story of this fascinating tea is connected to the historical method of monkeys trained to harvest the very tips of the tea trees without breaking the branches. The art of monkeys maneuvering in between branches to pick the best tea leaves in the shortest time is an extraordinary sensation like no other! It has slight nuances of honey.

Artistic show teas are also known as "Flower Bud Teas", "Show Teas", or it is sometimes called "Garden in the Pot". Ultra-high grade green tea leaves tied into a ball with globe amaranth flowers. This was a tribute tea enjoyed by Emperor Qianlong of the Qing Dynasty.

Bouquet of Love *

Truly a "Garden in the Pot", picturesque moving canvas of flowers opening inside a teapot. Elegance of chrysanthemum and jasmine flowers resonate with green and white teas into something memorable and connecting.

Ali High Mountain Green Oolong Taiwan **

Ali Mountain is famous for its superior High Mountain tea cultivation in Taiwan. Its abilities to gradually unlock aroma and flavours makes it ideal for multiple infusions each offering a different energy, taste, feeling, story and experience every time. The perfect example of the four elements and seasons, where you go or how long you go for on your exciting tea adventure is always unpredictable with this tea. Maximum of two leaves and one bud are hand plucked and dried with delicacy to reveal a mosaic of floral, woody and sweet aroma and flavours, changing with every infusion. Fragrance and drinking cups are used to appreciate this unique tea.

Ali High Mountain Ruby Oolong Taiwan **

Ali Mountain is well-known for its amazing energy and stories connected to oolong tea making at low to medium level of oxidisation, making it grassy and refreshing. This time, the oxidisation went a little step further to bordering that of black tea, exceeding the oxidation level of Oriental Beauty. Big leaf style tea leaves are plucked, then exposed under the sun, before proceeding to oxidation chambers at low temperature for about 48-72hrs to achieve high overall oxidisation. Final product is a cup filled with black tea flavours, yet retaining multi-facet characteristics of an Oolong. This tea has a bright deep amber liquor, filled with rich fruit fragrance, and finished with an aftertaste of honey, excellent for vintage.

Da Yu Ling Taiwan ***

Da Yu Ling has a wonderful fragrance and taste. It is a lightly oxidised oolong tea with a refreshing palate that is sought after by the most demanding tea connoisseurs. Da Yu Ling is produced in limited quantities and is one of the most prized teas of Taiwan. Da Yu Ling oolong tea is a premium-grade oolong tea from the Da Yu Ling area of Taiwan's Taichung county, Mount Li area (Li Shan or Pear Mountain). Its high altitude (more than 2600 meters) makes this one of the highest tea plantations in the world. High altitude plantation of Da Yu Ling means that tea leaves grow

slower and hence translate and develop its rich flavours slower into our mouths. To fully appreciate this fine oolong tea, brew it in the gong fu style.

Dong Ding Taiwan *

One of the finest Formosa Oolongs, 'Dong Ding' stands for 'Frozen Peaks', indicating the high-altitude tea plantations of highest quality production. Hand-plucked in Taiwan, this tea is well-known for its exceptional fragrance, full body, slight fruitiness, mild sweetness and irresistible reminiscence of a mouth-watering peach.

GABA Taiwan **

This tea was introduced and developed in Taiwan following Japanese research on the GABA molecule during the 1980s. Gamma-aminobutyric acid (GABA), a chemical made in the brain. An inhibitory neurotransmitter, GABA reduces a nerve cell's ability to send and receive chemical messages throughout the central nervous system. GABA is an amino acid that helps to regulate mood; hence GABA is at times referred to as the calming neurotransmitter. It is known for lowering stress and anxiety.

Milky Jin Shuan Taiwan *

From newly cultivated tea trees in Nantou and Chiayi, Taiwan, these thick and plump leaves are freshly tender with a lustrous emerald green colour. The taste is pure and smooth with an elegant, subtle milky sweet flavour and a floral aroma. It produces excellent flavours with up to seven infusions.

Organic oolong Taiwan **

High Mountain Oolong, organically grown in the cloudy mountains, it leaves sweet, grassy and lingering sensations... Aromatic and ceremonial.

Oriental Beauty Taiwan **

Also known as 'Bai Hao', 'Pong Hong Dei', 'White-Haired Oolong Tea' or 'Champagne Formosa' - this is the finest of some of the best Oolong in Taiwan. This highly oxidized tea boasts a sweet smooth taste, slightly baked and floral aroma and a somewhat fruity and honey scent. The origin of its name dates back to the early 20th century when locals named it 'You must be Joking Tea' after an interesting tea making accident. A British tea merchant presented a sample of this tea to Queen Victoria and the grand name "Oriental Beauty" came to life.

Red Jade Taiwan **

Well known as 'Red' or 'Red Jade', this is the one of the highest fermented oolong in the category of oolong produced in Fulu Tea District, Taitung County Taiwan. The fermentation level is known to be as high as 80-90%, hence it is also known as the black tea of oolong. Correctly termed, its unique production method of stirring tea leaves over heat, (key step of oolong production) and undergoing full black fermentation. This highly oxidised tea is rich in brown colour like a black tea, yet manifests a rounded sweet oolong aroma and mouth feel. For those interested in the tea history, Asia's "Red" tea is translated to "Black" tea in the West, strangest things happen in history.

Te Guan Yin Taiwan **

'Te Guan Yin', also known as 'Iron Goddess of Mercy', is traditionally grown in Fujian Province and produced from a specific type of tea bush. This Oolong has fine, dark leaves that produce infusions with long aftertastes of earthy flavours similar to roasted nuts. It produces excellent flavour with up to five infusions.

Scented Oolong

Blue Dragon Phoenix **

Heavenly combination of spring harvested tender green and white tea scented with freshly picked jasmine flower to form the famous Jasmine Dragon Phoenix Pearls. When further accompanied with blue Butterfly Pea Flowers, the dragon and phoenix can be seen dancing in the illuminating blue ocean!

Dang Gui Oolong *

Dang Gui is one of the many Chinese Angelica Roots well known for thousands of years in China, Japan and Korea for its sweet and root-like flavour and its unique natural medicinal properties. Semi-fermented top-quality tea is scented with Dang Gui root to give us this special tea appreciated by few.

Ginseng oolong *

Ginseng literally means 'Man Root'. Well-known for its uplifting blood circulation and energy, the ginseng roots are flavoured into the Oolong to produce an amazing combination of sweet and earthy tones. It has a distinct spicy, minty, sweet and crispy aftertaste.

Jasmine Bai Hao China *

Top-quality, semi-fermented oolong is scented with jasmine blossoms and then removed, which leaves the tea with a delightful jasmine flavour and scent. This tea was formerly reserved for the use in the Imperial Court, and a small taste will confirm that this is clearly not your typical jasmine.

Jasmine Dragon Phoenix Pearls China **

This famous tea is made from tender and healthy green tea shoots hand-picked in spring. Long leaf tips are scented with freshly cut jasmine blossoms which are then rolled into small pearls. The pearls seem to dance as they unfurl in the pot.

Osmanthus Taiwan *

Oolong has a wide range of fermentation between 25% and 70%. This Oolong manifests a fermentation of around 40%. This Taiwanese Oolong is based on the traditional specialty of the province of Gangxi in the south of China. Small-leaved Oolong tea leaves are mixed with fresh Osmanthus blossoms from Northern Taiwan's perfect climate and landscape. Harvested early in the morning between 4 and 7am to reflect the best aromatic qualities for the scenting process before dried together with Oolong. Well-known for its relaxation and digestive properties, this yellow infusion has a mild, fruity flavour reminiscent of caramel. Osmanthus blossoms are amongst the three most celebrated blossoms in the East, alongside Jasmine and Chrysanthemum flowers. Due to the semi-fermented category of this fine oolong, it can last as much as 5 consecutive infusions, with the first few infusions representing grassy green tea followed by the last few infusions representing woody black tea... All while embraced in elegant blooming fragrance.

Peach Jasmine *

When sweet blooming jasmine is paired with peach, tea connection is rapidly raised to a whole different level. Resonance of fruity and floral notes is aimed to extend the sentimental experience. This angelic tea releases memories reflecting fluffy clouds and blossoming petals.

Pomelo Flower Oolong Organic Taiwan **

Pomelo flower tea is a cultural tea offering by the indigenous Hakka tribe in Taiwan. This method of tea making is truly special, and has been perfected through time. During the month of March every year, the pomelo season arrive where the pomelo flowers blossom to their fullest. Blossoms are harvested before noon to avoid any excess moistures like dew, before being packed with tea leaves at 1:1 ratio in a approximately 75oC environment for complete scenting process to commence. Traditionally, pomelo teas are tea leaves packed inside a fresh hollowed pomelo trunks followed by 9 cycles of heating with steam and hot air, making it a very incredible hard-pressed tea, which can be aged for years. Pomelo flower tea together with chrysanthemum, jasmine and osmanthus, form four of the most influential flowers in the scented flower tea category. What makes pomelo flower tea a little different, is that each flower stamen, pistil and ovary is removed by hand first before scenting, leaving only petals, resulting in a cup with refreshing rich body sweet and floral liquor of elegance.

Rose Oolong *

A beautiful blend of rose petals and Taiwanese Oolong brings forth the floral, grassy and sweet notes of the high mountains.

Assam Bukhial TGFOP1 India

Assam full leaf 2nd flush tea has a typical strong and earthy flavour. Bukhial is a tea estate belonging to and managed by George Williamson Assam Ltd - the world's largest privately held tea plantation group in India. Situated on the south side of the Brahmaputra River in the state of Assam near a remote region called Nagaland, wild elephants still roam the state, but it could be worse; a century ago headhunters also lurked in the forests! In this area, rainfall is lower, so the bushes grow slower resulting in an outstanding tea, and if well-made, this orthodox tea produces a strong, mature cup full of character.

Ceylon Pettiagalla OP1 Sri Lanka

This fine Ceylon comes from the Dimbula area in the Sri Lankan Balangoda District. Thanks to its excessive moisture in rainy seasons and ultra-fertile topography, a dark red colour, highly aromatic and simultaneously mild taste is the combination of the outcome of this fine Ceylon. The infusion is equally excellent without milk, which makes Ceylon an excellent representation of a fully-fermented tea of about 95% in the black tea category.

Darjeeling 1st Flush Blend India

First flush teas are from the spring harvest to release light, fresh and flowery tones reminiscent of muscatel or green almonds. Darjeelings are termed as the 'Heaven of Tea' in India for their crisp and beautiful lingering sensations.

Darjeeling 2nd Flush Blend India
